The Inn on Biltmore Estate

The four-star Inn on Biltmore Estate is one of two hotels located on the 8,000-acre estate of Biltmore in Asheville, N.C., a National Historic Landmark. It shares the property with Biltmore House, America's largest home, completed in 1895 as the family home of George W. Vanderbilt. Biltmore's 80-acres of landscaped gardens were created by Frederick Law Olmsted, also known for his design of Central Park, and maintain the integrity and spirit of Olmsted's original vision. In addition to two overnight accommodation options, Biltmore today includes Antler Hill Village, which features the award-winning Biltmore Winery and Antler Hill Farm; Equestrian Center; numerous restaurants; events and meeting venues.

The Inn on Biltmore Estate consistently ranks on readers' polls and best-of lists of some of the most prestigious travel publications such as *Forbes Travel Guide*, *Travel + Leisure* and others. The hotel is recognized as a four-star property by *Forbes Travel Guide*, four-diamonds from AAA, named "Best Hotel in the South 2017" by *Southern Living*, and has landed recognition in *Condé Nast Traveler's* Gold List.

The Inn opened in 2001 and is a 210-room hotel (including nine suites) that reflects the beauty of Biltmore House and carries on the Vanderbilt tradition of gracious hospitality. Guests experience outstanding views, fine dining, and personalized service in luxurious surroundings.

Surrounded by the Blue Ridge Mountains, The Inn's interior is full of light and offers beautiful mountain views. Fresh cut flowers fill the lobby; wrought iron accents provide artistic touches. Comfortable common sitting areas, a library, an outdoor rimless pool and hot tub, and gourmet dining are a few examples of The Inn's amenities.

The furnishings and décor in rooms comes from Fine Furniture Design's Biltmore Collection. These pieces take inspiration from Biltmore's grounds, gardens, art and architectural details in their design. Luxurious baths, custom robes and slippers, turndown service and round-the-clock in-room dining are examples of the amenities that guests enjoy.

The Dining Room

The white-tablecloth service at the Dining Room serves the season's finest local and estate-raised ingredients, meats, seafood and handmade pasta. The setting is warm and convivial with mountain views for breakfast and dinner. Among other accolades, The Dining Room has been recognized in Open Table Diner's Choice Awards for best food, service, ambiance and best overall.

The Library & Veranda

George Vanderbilt's Library in Biltmore House inspired designers to create The Library, a setting for a light lunch, afternoon tea or a signature cocktail. Guests may select a book from the shelves, sink into a plush library chair with a

glass of Biltmore wine and admire views of the French Broad River and mountain views from the Library's windows. The west-facing Veranda, complete with rocking chairs, offers stunning views of amazing sunsets.

Recreational Pursuits

Beyond Biltmore's unique rimless pool, hot tub, spa and fitness center, there is an 8,000-acre "backyard" ready to serve a variety of interests. The Inn's concierge can arrange hiking, biking, guided rafting tours, stand-up paddleboarding, horseback riding, carriage rides, Segway tours, sporting clays, fly fishing and the Land Rover Experience Driving School—all located on the estate. Off-site golf courses can be recommended and tee times arranged by the concierge. Biltmore offers seasonal complimentary wellness activities for overnight guests, such as morning yoga and guided hikes on select dates.
